INFANT NURSERY POLICY

Please read the following policy regarding nursery services. By signing this policy you signify you have **READ**, **UNDERSTAND** and **ACCEPT** the responsibilities that accompany it each Sunday.

PRIOR TO ARRIVAL OF CHILDREN:

- Volunteer staff will arrive in the nursery at least 15 minutes prior to the start time of nursery.
- Shoes will be removed prior to entering the child-care area. In the event of sandal/flip-flop weather socks will be provided and must be worn inside the child-care area.
- No food (other than snack for children) is allowed in the nursery. Hot drinks should remain out of reach of all children.

As CHILDREN ARRIVE:

- Verify that each child has been given a bracelet, indicating they have been properly signed in.
- As needed, pagers should be signed out to each family.
 Mandatory. For health and safety reasons, parents must be paged/texted for all diaper changes.
 - Unless a parent requests otherwise, only page/text if a child has a bowel movement.
- Snacks are located in the large cupboard in the nursery entry. Opened snacks should be used first. **Important.** Before serving snacks verify on the attendance list that there are no allergy or health concerns.

AFTER THE SERVICE:

• The only person that may pick up a child is the parent who presents the tab with the matching code on the child's bracelet.

Mandatory. DO NOT release any child to any adult without this tab.

- Snacks will be returned to main cupboard.
- Any sippy-cups or toys known to have been in a child's mouth will be washed.
- Bouncers, walkers, or toys unable to be washed in the sink will be wiped down with Clorox wipes.
- All books & toys will be picked up off the floor and put on the shelves.
- Important. Take trash to the ladies room & replace trash bag (in the cupboard under the sink).
- Vacuum the nursery floor; wipe down countertops and surfaces with Clorox wipes; spray Lysol in the trash, on door handles or on any other surface that may need to be sanitized.
- Lights & AC are turned off and windows & and door are closed.

Please advise Nursery Coordinator of any supplies that are getting low.
