PARENTS - Please read the following **Nursery Policy**.

By signing this policy you signify you have **read**, **UNDERSTAND** and **ACCEPT** the responsibilities that accompany it each Sunday. **IT IS EXPECTED THAT IF A CHILD USES THE NURSERY, AT LEAST ONE PARENT MUST VOLUNTEER TO HELP IN NURSERY A MINIMUM OF ONCE PER QUARTER.**

* The word parents is used to refer to whomever assumes legal responsibility for the child.

SIGN IN

- Parents must sign-in their child(ren) EACH Sunday. Any special instructions (i.e. allergies, time to be fed, people not permitted to pick up child, etc.) must be specified/updated with sign-in volunteer.
- Each child will receive a Tyvek bracelet indicating they have been signed-in. Parent will receive tab with bracelet's corresponding numeric code. Parents **MUST** retain tab. For security purposes, children will be released only to the parent presenting the tab that corresponds to child's bracelet.

PAGERS

• Pagers will be assigned and handed out by a nursery volunteer **ONLY**. The nursery staff is not permitted to change diapers or assist children in the bathroom. Parents will be paged if their child needs assistance with either of these. Pagers are to be returned at the end of each nursery.

PICK UP

- Parents will pick up and sign children out of nursery immediately following the close of service.
- Parents **MUST** present their tab and may only pick up children with a corresponding code.

TIME OUTSIDE

During warm weather, preschool nursery may be taken outside to the fenced in play area on the left rear side of the building. Notification will be given to parents prior to playing outside. If the child has an allergy, other health issue, or the parent prefers the child stay indoors, volunteers are instructed to stay inside with them.

SICK CHILDREN Please DO NOT bring your child into nursery with any of the following.

• FEVER OR ANY FLU-LIKE SYMPTOMS

PERSISTENT OR PRODUCTIVE COUGH

- DIARRHEA OR VOMITING
- HEAD LICE

- CONJUNCTIVITIS (OR PINK EYE)
- STREP THROAT/ CONTAGIOUS DISEASES (CHICKEN POX, ETC.) Children receiving antibiotics for strep throat or any other contagious disease **MUST** have been on antibiotics for a full *48 hours* before attending nursery.
- RUNNY NOSE It is understandable that some children may have allergies or that dry air may cause a few sniffles. Any noses with **GREEN** mucus will not be allowed in nursery.
